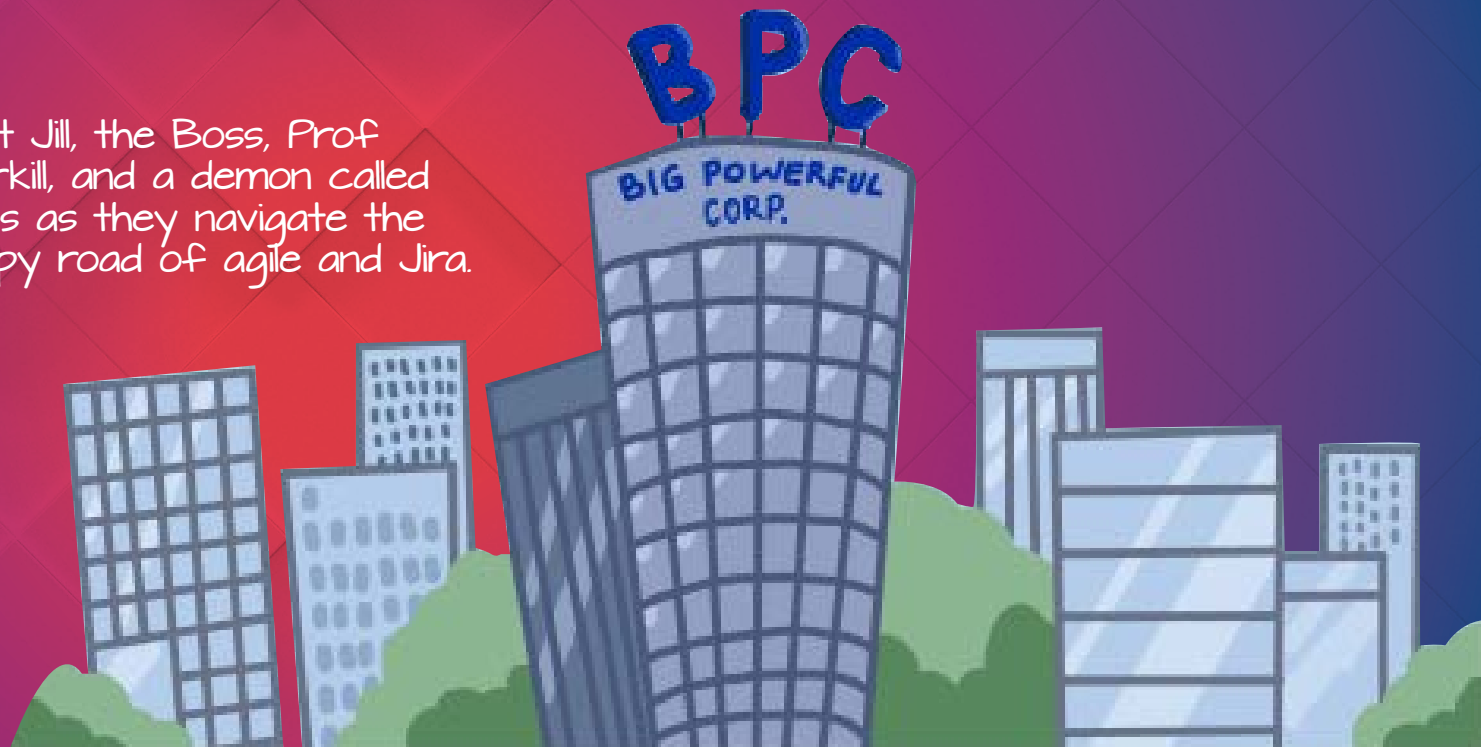




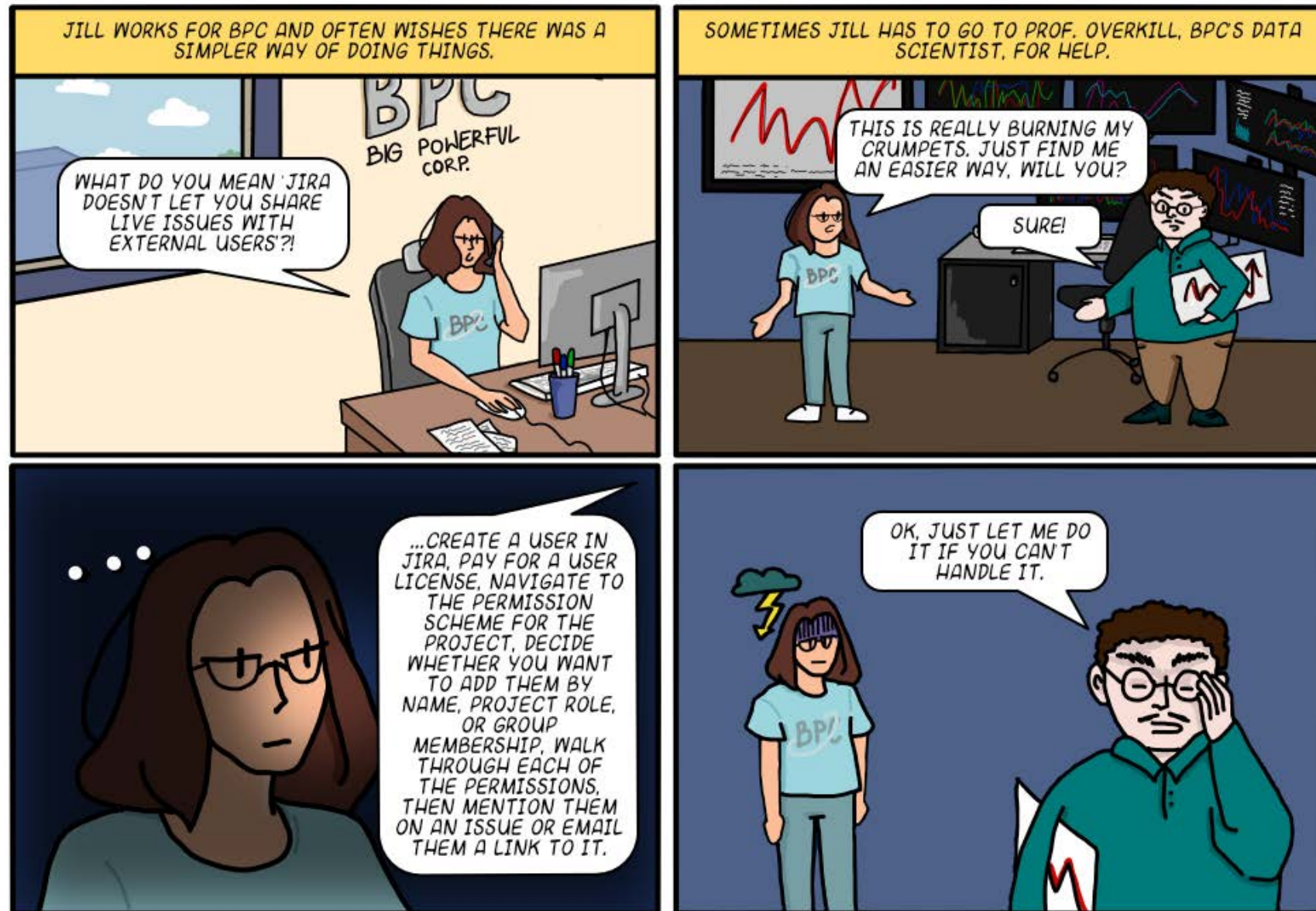

Meet Jill, the Boss, Prof Overkill, and a demon called Silops as they navigate the bumpy road of agile and Jira.

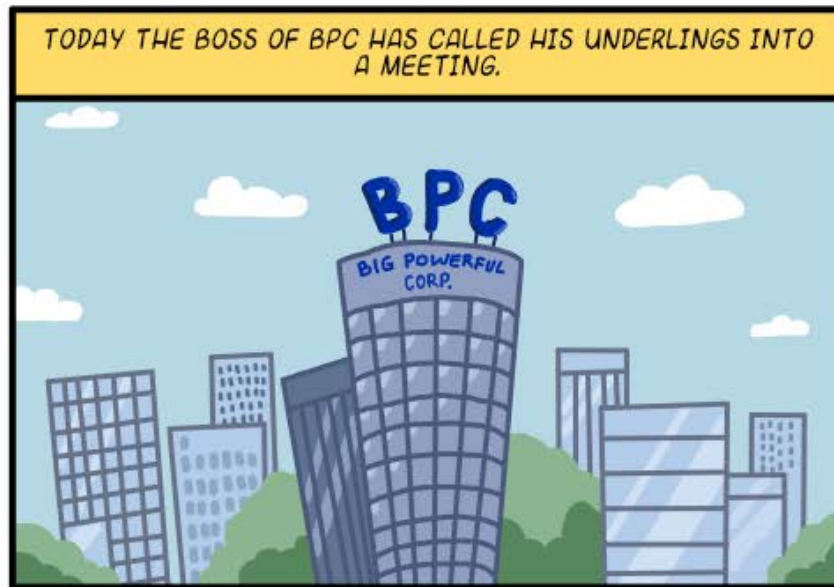
