
- TL;DR: We're introducing a new navigation system for Trello in order to:

#### Premortem

Use this template to run a premortem session for your project. Ideally you'll schedule yourself 90 minutes, but if you're short on time, you can do it in 60 minutes.

#### Pre-work

Include these questions in the meeting invite and ask everyone to spend 5-10 minutes thinking through how they'd answer them (no need to write the answers down):

- What could slow us down or make us miss our deadline for launch?
- What are we already nervous about?
- Where did you discover blind spots on past projects?
- How quickly can we respond when something goes wrong?
- Who could own each of our biggest risk areas?



# **FAQs for Support Team**

While we expect the majority of users to view the new navigation as an overall **positive** change, there will inevitably be those who are frustrated. Here are the questions we most anticipate.

Question	Suggested answer
Why did Trello change its navigation? How does this benefit me?	We wanted to make it easier and faster to find the boards you needed. We also wanted to give you clarity and value in how you organize your boards into Workspaces.
I can't find the boards I'm looking for in the new sidebar	The new sidebar shows you boards within the selected Workspace. To see boards in another Workspace, select that Workspace from the "Workspaces" dropdown in the global header.
